

PROCEEDINGS OF THE 9TH DMF TRUST BOARD MEETING HELD ON 02.05.2020 AT 11.00 AM IN DURBAR HALL, COLLECTORATE, KEONJHAR

The 9th Trust Board Meeting of DMF as per Clause 8 of the DMF Trust Deed was held on 02.05.2020 at 11.00 AM in Durbar Hall, Collectorate, Keonjhar under the chairmanship of Sri Ashish Thakare, IAS, Collector-cum-Chairman & Managing Trustee, DMF. The list of participants is enclosed in the Annexure-I.

The meeting was preceded by a visit of all the trust board members to the dedicated 200 bedded COVID Hospital at Ranki set up under DMF, where the Collector apprised the members about the medical infrastructure, equipment and services contrived for people suspected/infected with coronavirus. He further informed that, the medical equipment and furniture have been purchased in the name of CDM&PHO and placed at COVID hospital. Post COVID, these equipment will then be transferred for use in other public health facilities of the district. The trust board members appreciated the efforts taken by DMF in converting an under-construction hostel into a full-fledged hospital in such a short span of time.

At the outset of the meeting, the Collector welcomed all the members and participants who attended the meeting. P.D., DRDA-cum-Chief Executive Officer, DMF elaborated the list of projects approved in the last Trust Board meeting held on 15.11.2018 and the corresponding proceedings sent to all members was confirmed & approved by the members.

Then as per the agenda note, various matters were discussed sequentially. The Collector informed the meeting that over the last couple of years DMF has been successfully grounding various projects and consolidating its efforts to provide sustainable benefits to the people living in mining affected areas of the district.

The Collector then presented a power point slideshow, detailing the DMF fund accrual and expenditure made across major sectors and departments. The accrual and expenditure details as on 31.03.2020 which was presented in the meeting are as mentioned below:

Total Receipt of funds:

Rs. 4408.43 Crore

Sanction of funds:

Rs. 2541.55 Crore

Utilisation of funds:

Rs. 1295.62 Crore

Following this, Collector also highlighted various initiatives taken up under DMF during the COVID-19 pandemic situation where funds have been placed with all BDOs, R&B Keonjhar/Ghatagaon, all EO Municipalities, ORMAS and CDM&PHO for equipping PHCs, CHCs/DHH, creating isolation facilities, manufacturing masks by SHGs and establishment of dedicated COVID Hospital for containing the spread of coronavirus in Keonjhar.



Following this, Hon'ble MLA Sadar & member of the Trust appreciated the projects taken up under DMF which has covered almost every sector. However, he expressed his concern on delay in holding of DMF Trust Board meeting. He mentioned that around one and half years has lapsed since the last meeting. The Collector while responding to this mentioned that the delay is attributed to several factors. Firstly, the model code of conduct for Lok Sabha and State Assembly elections was in force during 10th March-26th May 2019. Thereafter, for the induction of new members in DMF Trust Board, the list was notified by government only on 27th September 2019. Post this, Parliament and State Legislative Assembly was in session till mid-December 2019. Later, when it was proposed to hold the meeting during February 2020, due to some other engagements of Hon'ble Minister & MLA Telkoi & MLA Sadar, it could not be solemnised and upon their request had to be postponed for a later date.

Further, Hon'ble M.L.A., Sadar requested to provide the annual report of the DMF to all the members. He added that since Keonjhar district is coming under TSP area and as per PESA Act, all the projects should be placed before the Gram Sabha for their approval. He also advised that the proceedings of each Gram Sabha should be a part of case record of the project. The Collector informed that it is mandatory for all departments to take Gram Sabha approval whenever they are sanctioned a project under DMF and it is their responsibility to organize and maintain the records.

While discussing about Mega Piped Water Supply system, Hon'ble MLA, Sadar opined that permission from the Water Resources Department should be taken before execution of the drinking water projects which will use surface water resources/reservoirs, in this case Mirigisingha located in Champua Block. EE, RWS&S Division, Keonjhar while responding to this, clarified that the approval for supply of drinking water from the reservoirs has been duly taken from the Department of Water Resources before it was put to tender. Subsequently, Hon'ble MLA, Sadar hypothesized that the DMF collection may fall in future as the existing mines of the district have been auctioned this year and the bid amount is unrealistic high, to which Collector informed that the matter is beyond the purview of the district administration.

Hon'ble Minister & MLA, Telkoi then proposed to improve the infrastructure of all Govt., Govt. Aided & Non-aided schools of the district. The Collector informed him that till date infrastructure of around 54 High Schools and 130 elementary schools have been enhanced, including the construction of additional classrooms under DMF. Additionally, as per the suggestion, Collector directed DEO/DPC SSA to assess requirements and submit proposal for further action. Additionally, the Hon'ble Minister highlighted the plight of villagers, where there are patches of roads which connects two districts, which he said are in a bad shape. He suggested to undertake such roads either under DMF/OMBADC to ease out the movement of people residing at border area. Collector directed EE, RWD, Keonjhar to undertake an assessment of the said roads and submit for further action.





Hon'ble MLA, Anandapur requested the Collector to take up the road projects in non-mining areas of Hatadihi Block which were previously approved in DMF Trust Board. In this regard, the Collector expressed that the roads of non-mining areas can be taken up through OMBADC funds and requested the department to submit the proposals under OMBADC. Hon'ble MLA also added that the boundary wall and approach road of OAV situated at Sundarapal of Saha G.P. of Hatadihi block should be taken up out of DMF. Collector directed DEO Keonjhar to submit a report in this regard. Hon'ble MLA Anandapur also suggested taking up higher education institutions under DMF. Collector informed him that +2/+3 colleges of mining areas are proposed to be upgraded under DMF and have been approved in earlier DMF trust board. He informed that necessary steps will be taken to take up govt and govt aided colleges under DMF while for those falling in areas other than mining areas may be taken up through OMBADC.

Hon'ble MLA Sadar then enquired with the Collector regarding the grounds based on which an extension was given to the PMU - DMF. Collector responded mentioning the fact that the MoU which was signed with Ernst and Young Pvt Ltd in April, 2017 includes extension by two years post completion of three years, based on satisfactory performance. Therefore, considering the signficant work done by the PMU in the last 3 years, an extension has been given for another two years.

Sarapanch, Rasol & members of DMF Trust Board proposed to approve the construction of ANM Centre building of Daitary under DMF. He also provided list of projects to which Collector requested EE, RWD to verify its feasibility and submit for further action.

Vice Chairman, Joda Block & member of DMF Trust Board proposed to devise a plan to arrest the moving of stray cows near Jhadgaon & Bhadrasahi villages.

ZP Member & member of DMF Trust Board proposed for posting of Doctor, Pharmacist & Staff Nurse in Kanjipani PHC (new)./She further proposed to construct the staff quarters inside the PHC campus for accommodation of the health staff to provide better service to the public.

The Collector thanked the trust board members for giving their views and suggestions and directed once again the concerned line departments to undertake an assessment of the requests made by the members and submit a report in this regard for further action.

Approval of new projects

The list of projects placed before the Trust Board for deliberation was approved as per Clause 5 and 6 (2) of the ODMF rules and Clause 6 (2) of the DMF Trust Deed and is enclosed at Annexure II. The Collector then requested all the members to propose projects to be taken up under DMF and directed the concerned departments to carry out a feasibility assessment for further action under DMF.



At last, the P.D., DRDA-cum-C.E.O. thanked all the members and participants for their valuable suggestions and the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
