The 5th Trust Board meeting of District Mineral Foundation, Keonjhar was held on 04.09.2017 at 04.00 PM under the Chairmanship of Dr. N. Thirumala Naik, I.A.S. Collector, Keonjhar and Chairperson-cum-Managing Trustee, DMF, Keonjhar. The members present in the meeting is at "Annexure-A".

At the outset, Chairperson-cum-Managing Trustee welcomed all the members to the meeting and appraised the house that previously basing on the list of mining affected villages received from P.R. Department under Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana, the same was accepted by DMF, Keonjhar. In the last Trust Board Meeting, as was decided, DDM Joda & Mining Officer, Keonjhar have submitted a total list of 495 villages which are coming within 10 km radius of mines. They have prepared the list basing on topo sheet mapping. Earlier, the total list of mining affected villages was 242 and there was request from the members for inclusion of more villages.

The list of 495 villages was placed before the Trust Board for information of the members. After discussion the list was approved. Further, it was also suggested by Collector that ORSAC should be requested to identify the villages coming within 10 kilometre radius of mines in a scientific and error free manner. The proposal was also approved by the Trust Board after discussion.

As regards indirect mining affected villages, it was opined that there is no specific definition / clarity basing upon which the list of such villages can be identified. Thus, it was decided to move Govt. to clarify the matter.

In course of discussion, Hon'ble Member & MLA, Champua raised the bad condition of the road from Dabuna to Ranasal. Hon'ble Member also spoke that under Govt. housing scheme the unit cost is inadequate as because sand is not locally available and the same is being transported from Anandapur which is 150 km away. He suggested to move the Govt. to enhance the Unit Cost.

It was decided to submit the proposal to Govt. for 4-laning of Bamebari-Joda Ranasala road under NH.

- 2. Collector-cum-Managing Trustee apprised the Trust Board members that the State Cabinet has approved for execution of Govt. Medical College & Hospital at Keonjhar. Also tender for the work has been finalised in favour of M/s Tata Projects Ltd. at a cost of Rs.381.78 crore. DMF has already placed ₹55.00 crore for the purpose. As required Para-5(e) of Odisha District Mineral Foundations (Amendment) Rules, 2015 the Trust Board has to accord administrative approval to the project for execution. Elaborate discussion over the matter was made and the Trust Board accorded A/A to the project and expressed that the project should be completed within the time limit of 24 months.
- 3. Preparation of Perspective Annual Plan was discussed. The Collector-cum-Managing Trustee apprised the members that for undertaking various development works in the mining affected villages it is necessary for preparation of detailed planning and reputed firms having working experience in the field is to be engaged for preparation of plan. It was decided to engage a reputed firm having experience in such field work who would be able to submit the report within 3 to 6 months. The Trust Board approved the suggestion for further action. The expenditure in this regard is to be met out of administrative expenses of DMF.
- 4. Hon'ble MLA, Champua suggested for construction of library building and provision of books for different colleges of the district. Wherever building is available, books can be given to the colleges. It was decided to collect college wise information for necessary consideration.
- 5. Hon'ble MLA, Champua raised the repairing of road from OMC Office to Birsa Munda Chowk of Barbil. Collector apprised that estimates for this work has been received from R&B, Keonjhar and it will be cleared soon.
- 6. Hon'ble MLA also spoke that the saving amount of AWC building should be be spent for the same centre by taking up extra required work/beautification instead of surrendering to Govt.
- 7. Hon'ble MLA spoke on substandard work done by RW division for the road work Jhargaon Bhuyanroida and funded by M/s OMC Ltd. at a cost of ₹98.31 lakh. It was decided to request Chief Engineer, RW to get the matter enquired into by a technical team.

The following projects proposed are also approved in 5th Trust Board.

- A rest-shed at JNV, Hadgarh
- Construction of additional classrooms at JNV, Hadgarh
- Development play ground at JNV Hadgarh and Kendriya Vidyalaya Keonjhar
- Recreation Centre for Senior Citizen at Keonjhar, Joda and Barbil
- Distribution of Aids and Appliance to Disabled Persons
- Weaving-cum-stitching unit at Banspal Block.
- Setting up of a coaching centre at Keonjhar for competitive exams
- Provision of cots for Urban deprived inmates at Keonjhar and Barbil @ 50 Cots
 Per Hostel .
- Additional Classrooms, Library and other Infrastructure for +2 and +3 Colleges in mining affected area.

Lastly, Project Director, DRDA, Keonjhar-cum-Chief Executive, DMF, Keonjhar conveyed the vote of thanks to the Collector & Chairperson and the members present in the meeting for their valuable suggestions.
